\* Number Writing fun: Children can have fun practicing their numbers by writing them in shaving cream, flour, sugar or other movable materials. Then they can write the numbers down on paper and circle their best ones.

Goal: Children will be able to sharpen their number writing skills.

Materials: One type of preferred choice, (Flour, sugar shaving cream, play sand, finger paint etc.), washable surface: cookie sheet, tray, tabletop, to work on and make for easy clean up. Number direction card, paper (Lined if possible), pencils

Activity: Have a washable surface to work on. Put shaving cream on the surface (please use what you have at home from materials list. I will reference shaving cream)

- \*Have child help you set up. Then they can reference cards and practice writing their numbers in the material.
- \*Remind children to write numbers coming down from the top to bottom.
- \*After they have some fun writing in the material of choice, have them help you clean up.
- \*Then on paper, have your child practice writing the numbers 0-10. Have them do each number 5 times and then circle the one they think is their best.
